## Online Out-of-Catchment and Out-of-Division Requests - February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024

All SJASD school webpages will have a link for an **online waitlist** for students who wish to apply for a "school of choice" outside of their catchment area for the 2024-25 school year. <u>This link</u> will begin to accept requests on Friday, Feb. 16<sup>th</sup> beginning at 8:00 am. All students on this waitlist must first register at their catchment school. This waitlist will close on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Families on the waitlist will be notified of the status of their request on or before June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

<u>Grade 6 and 9 Information Evenings</u>: Students and their families who are new to each school will have the opportunity to engage in an in-person school information event which is scheduled after the registration deadline. Lincoln Middle School's information evening happens on Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup> from 6:00-7:00 pm. Westwood Collegiate (and all other senior years schools) will be hosting their information event on the evening of Tuesday, March 12<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 - 7:00 pm.
