Counsellor in the Classroom Presentations

May is Mental Health Awareness Month. Students in grade 8 will have the opportunity to participate in the Counsellor in the Classroom program to promote the discussion of mental health and well-being. Students will gain a better understanding of what mental health is and learn more about Kids Help Phone services. The program has two main sections. First, teachers lead their class through curriculum and activities that equip students with basic mental health knowledge and prepare them for a group call with a Kids Help Phone counsellor. Second, a counsellor will video chat with the class where they help to further educate about Kids Help Phone and answer any class questions. There are also optional extension activities that the teacher can lead with the class to expand their learning.
