All classrooms, including our modular classrooms are scheduled for occupancy. The 3 modular classrooms will be occupied by two of our grade 4/5 classrooms and the library.

At Phoenix School, the creation of balanced classes is fundamental in supporting the diverse needs of all learners. The class creation process is a complex one involving the careful examination of student learning profiles by the Phoenix team (all teachers, student services, and administration) to determine positive student placements and classroom communities.

In the interest of balanced classes and considering the needs of all learners, we thank all families for not requesting specific placements. Classroom placements will be included on final report cards.

#### **Modular Classrooms Update**

Final construction continues to happen and/or be scheduled for our new modular classrooms, including the relocation of the school library shelving and book collections. Some additional asphalt paving is scheduled near the modular classrooms. Hydro is completed. The division IT department will be installing IT requirements shortly. These new learning spaces will be scheduled for occupancy in September, 2024.

#### **Safety First**

Students riding bicycles to school are reminded to wear a helmet and to use a bike lock. Phoenix School will be having the second of two required practice lockdowns this week.



## **About The Run**

Headingley Fire Department held their first Run for Wishes in May of 2001. Numbers of participants were small and we had just a few sponsors. Over the past 20 years, our run has evolved and grown. We now host hundreds of runners and walkers and are now supported by over 40 sponsors. We are generating about \$20,000.00 every year and have been able to support The Children's Rehabilitation Foundation and Canadian Mental Health as well as numerous individuals who need support during difficult times in their lives over the course of the year.

Headingley Fire Department Run for Wishes is a sanctioned 5 km run, part of the Manitoba Runners Association run series that uses professional chip timing and a 3 km walk. The scenic route takes you over and along the Assiniboine River and through residential South Headingley. It starts and finishes at Headingley Fire Department and the event is followed by an awards ceremony and about 50 draw prizes. This event is perfect for the elite runner to the casual walker and everyone in-between.
