

ADDITIONAL ACCOMODATIONS FOR IN-CLASS STUDIES BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 28

Thank-you parents, students and teachers for your patience, flexibility, compassion, and kindness as we focus on continuing to provide our unique academic, arts, athletics and educational programming in the middle of a pandemic--both remotely and at school, while implementing Public Health and Safety Protocols!

Although we are at full capacity in most cases, on September 28, we will allow small groups of students on their home study day to attend specific in-school classes where we can maintain Public Health procedures due to small class size or larger classroom sizes.

Students will attend designated classes only on these days and will have to leave the school when not in class. Some exceptions may apply for bus students attending study spaces.

Teachers will need to adjust synchronous remote learning expectations in the cases where students are travelling to and from school.

The approved classes are typically in specialty areas and/or those classes (Arts / IB) that follow a year-long alternating day pattern in the timetable—more of these all-year courses are scheduled in Grades 11/12. The list may look long but on average only brings in an additional 25 students per class period across the school.

DOORS

Westwood Collegiate families should ensure vehicle drop-off happens as close to the grade designated door as possible:

Grade 12, NE Parking Lot main doors

Grade 11, SE Rouge and Sansome corner doors

Grade 10, SW Sansome doors

Grade 9, NW Field doors

WASHROOMS

North, front of office washrooms will be designated for the grade 11 and 12 students; South, guidance area washrooms will be designated for the grade 9 and 10 students.

Students:

- Do not arrive at school more then 10 minutes prior to your scheduled class.
- School bus students can wait outside, or at designated socially distanced waiting spots when weather is inclement.
- When arriving at school you will be required to report immediately to your first classroom.
- When moving about Westwood, students will be required to physically distance and follow hallway markings.
- There can be no congregating of students at any time throughout the day.
- Students are required to leave the school immediately after the end of their last class of the day.
- Classes may comprise of flexible groupings, team teaching and multiple and alternate locations to adjust to social distancing requirements.
- A PROCEED WHEN CLEAR protocol will be applied at class change: Grade 11/12 students may leave at the bell, and teachers determine when the hall is clear enough to allow Grade 9/10 to follow.

All students with last names beginning with the letters <u>A - K "Yellow Group"</u>, will attend 6 day cycle <u>odd</u> <u>days 1,3,5</u> in the school division six-day cycle.

All students with last names beginning with the letters $\underline{L} - \underline{Z''Blue\ Group''}$, will attend $\underline{even\ days\ 2,4,6}$ in the school division six-day cycle.
