JANUARY

- **January 8: Learn about Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)**

Drop in to talk with CRA staff to learn how you can get your benefits and where you may process your income tax.

- **January 15: Learn about Project Safe Audience (PSA)**

Drop in to talk with PSA staff to learn about their harm reduction initiative for the rave population.

- **January 22: Learn about Refugee Employment Development Initiative (REDI) joint with Manitoba Institute of Trades and Technology (MITT)**

Drop in to talk with REDI staff to learn about how this program provides refugees in Winnipeg a pathway into employment as production workers with manufacturing companies in Manitoba. It also helps them improve their English language skills and preparing students for work by providing quality language training while OFE provides extensive and proven employment training.

- **January 29: Learn about New Directions for Children, Youth, Adults & Families**

Drop in to talk with New Directions staff to learn how they provide supports to children, adolescents and adults that may have intellectual disability and/or physical disability.

FEBRUARY

- **February 5: Learn about Graffiti Art Programming (GAP)**

Drop in to talk with GAP staff about their community youth art centre. GAP provides free educational arts programs and practical training skills for youth.

- **February 12: Learn about Resource Assistance for Youth (RaY)**

Drop in to talk with RaY staff to learn about their programs and services; ie: drop-in, Level Up, housing, employment, education and health wellness.

- **February 19: Learn about Addictions Foundation of Manitoba (AFM)**

Drop in to talk with AFM staff to learn about the range of services and supports relating to alcohol, substance use and problem gambling.

- **February 26: Learn about Nine Circles Community Health Centre**

Drop in to talk with Nine Circles staff about their range of programs and services to clients to support them of where they are at with information and skills that will assist them in self-managing chronic conditions and reaching personal goals.
