Job Description:

Provides assistance in the education, development and training of students, particularly those experiencing significant learning, behavioural, social, and/or physical difficulties. Shifts are available on a call-in basis. Performs other related duties as assigned or as required.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Ability to work effectively with students experiencing significant learning, behavioral, social and/or physical difficulties.
- High school diploma plus the required knowledge to assist students academically.
- Training related to the specific requirements of challenged students.
- Paraeducator certificate or related diploma or degree preferred.
- 1 - 2 years related experience.
- Training in NVCI and/or WEVAS.
- Training in CPR and First Aid.
- Ability to regularly and safely lift and manoeuvre a minimum of 25 kgs.
- Ability to safely restrain a student for extended periods of time.
- Ability to work effectively with students experiencing significant learning, behavioral, social and/or physical difficulties.
- Ability to assist with special needs programs, such as personal hygiene, toileting, feeding, life skills, physiotherapy, alternative communication techniques, catheterization and all physical activities assigned indoors and out.
- Ability to communicate both verbally and in writing with all levels of staff, students, and the public.
- Ability to handle highly confidential information.
- Working conditions will include indoor and outdoor and may include swimming pool.
- May be required to have a valid Manitoba Driver's License and daily access to a vehicle.
- An equivalent combination of education and experience may be acceptable to the Division.
