READING CLINICIAN

The Reading Clinician is an integral member of the Educational Support Services team working closely with the Clinical Reading Team to provide expertise in literacy instruction and leadership through a continuum of services that include: consultation and collaboration, comprehensive diagnostic assessments, targeted interventions, and professional development.

Key Responsibilities:

- Consult and collaborate with school and interdisciplinary teams through an outcomes-driven model, offering data-informed recommendations that support diagnostic programming for individuals and groups of students
- Support classroom and resource teachers through demonstration and modelling of evidence-based literacy instruction, strategies, and assessments that are aligned with a structured literacy approach
- Assess referred students to determine literacy-learning strengths and needs using a variety of standardized and informal assessments and provide instructional recommendations and adaptations
- Deliver data-informed targeted instruction using structured literacy practices
- Consult with school division personnel on educational matters related to literacy instruction
- Keep current with research and practice in the field of literacy and education
- Serve as a liaison with community literacy organizations
- Provide professional development to school and division teams
- Plan and implement literacy initiatives
- Maintain accurate and current records and report on individual students receiving Reading Clinician support
- Provide ongoing support and training for Literacy Intervention Tutors in their daily work with students

Qualifications:

- Holds School Clinician's Certificate in Reading issued by Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning or be eligible to obtain said certificate
- Master's Degree of Education in Language and Literacy
- Teaching experience in which literacy instruction has been integral and contributes to a thorough understanding of current classroom and curricular demands
- Experience and expertise in a wide range of instructional literacy approaches, diagnostic instruction, interventions, and assessments
- Well-developed consultative and collaborative skills
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Ability to work within a variety of teams, including interdisciplinary teams
