#### Our opinion

In our opinion, the accompanying supplementary financial information of St. James-Assiniboia School Division (the School Division) for the calendar year ended December 31, 2019 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the basis of preparation described in the note to the supplementary financial information.

#### What we have audited

The School Division's supplementary financial information comprises the schedule of compensation equal to or over \$75,000 in accordance with the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Act of Manitoba for the calendar year ended December 31, 2019, and the related note (together, the supplementary financial information).

#### Basis for opinion

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

#### **Independence**

We are independent of the School Division in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the supplementary financial information in Canada. We have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements.

#### *Emphasis of matter – basis of accounting*

We draw attention to the note to the supplementary financial information, which describes the basis of accounting. The supplementary financial information is prepared to assist the School Division to comply with the specified requirements criteria established within the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Act of Manitoba. As a result, the supplementary financial information may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.



# Responsibilities of management and those charged with governance for the supplementary financial information

Management is responsible for the preparation of the supplementary financial information in accordance with the basis for preparation as described in the note to the supplementary financial information, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of supplementary financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the supplementary financial information, management is responsible for assessing the School Division's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the School Division or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
