OUT-OF-SCHOOL INSTRUCTION

The Board of Trustees recognizes that there may be medical situations preventing students from attending school for an extended period of time. In these situations the Division will provide some educational assistance in the form of tutoring for those students enrolled in the St. James-Assiniboia School Division. The purpose of this service is to help minimize the effect of being absent from school due to serious medical issues. The following conditions apply:

- The instructional assistance focuses on core curriculum that enhances literacy and numeracy.
- Tutoring services are provided in the home where feasible, to students within the St. James-Assiniboia School Division.
- Medical situations over one month to a maximum of 10 months.
- Services are provided on the basis of approximately four hours of instruction per week depending on the student's health. Tutorial assistance is generally not given at the onset of illness.
- Requests for assistance are directed through the school principal and the assignment of staff is made by the Administrator of Educational Support Services in consultation with the principal.

Long term illnesses (e.g. over a year or more) are to be considered individually by the Board.
