#### **CLASSIFICATION OF AWARDS**

Potential donors are asked to review the classification of awards when considering establishing a new award.

### **Scholarship**

A scholarship is a solely merit based award reflecting high academic achievement. A minimum B average is required.

#### Award

An award is based on both high academic achievement and financial need. Alternatively it can be based on good citizenship and/or service to the community. A minimum C+ average is required.

#### Prize

A prize is based on a more narrow academic achievement such as the highest standing in a single course of study or success in an essay or some other academic competition. A prize will normally have a significantly lower monetary value which may be less than \$100. A minimum of a B average is required.
