## JOINT USE AGREEMENTS

Schools and communities benefit from harmonized policies, procedures, and practices related to facility use, including the use of formal Joint Use Agreements. Joint Use Agreements with the Province of Manitoba, City of Winnipeg, and local municipalities will be considered by the School Division with the aim of ensuring maximum and optimal use of facilities.

Key issues such as space availability, use, zoning, usage fees, costs, security, liability, and insurance are all factors to be considered prior to the approval of a Joint Use Agreement.

Organizations interested in developing a Joint Use Agreement shall forward correspondence to the Secretary-Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer detailing:

- 1) Facility required
- 2) Use
- 3) Timeframe

All Joint Use Agreements must be approved by the Board of Trustees.
