ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

Subject to the provisions of <u>The Public Schools Act</u> all residents of school age shall be eligible to enroll in schools of the Division.

For purposes of the Division "children of school age" means children of ages five to seventeen years inclusive. Children who reach age five (5) before December 31st of any year, are eligible to enter Kindergarten in September of that year. To qualify as residents such pupils must fulfil the requirements defined in <u>The Public</u> <u>Schools Act</u> and must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants. Placement of a in a home in the Division by a government agency confers resident status.

<u>The Public Schools Act</u> states that "a person... has the right to attend school from the beginning of the fall term of that year until the last school day of June in the year in which the person becomes 21 years of age; or until the person receives a graduation diploma as defined in the regulations; whichever comes first."

To qualify as adult residents, individuals must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants and must, in fact, be residents as defined in <u>The Public Schools Act</u>.
