ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

This policy is applicable to the admission of students whose parents or legal guardians reside outside of the boundaries of the Division, but are Canadian citizens or permanent residents residing in Canada, exclusive of First Nation's students who are eligible for federally approved funding as per the Public Schools Act (PSA). Non-resident students are further defined in the PSA.

International students, exchange students, students accompanying parents or legal guardians who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents, non-permanent residents, and Canadian citizens or permanent residents whose parents or legal guardians reside outside of Canada are subject to the provisions of policy JFABB*.

Admission of a non-resident student will be in compliance with the Schools of Choice sections of the PSA as further outlined in this policy. Application for admission shall be made to the principal of the school in question. Approval will be determined by the principal and will be forwarded to the Assistant Superintendent, Administration. Acceptance is conditional upon payment of non-resident fees.

Non-resident students warranting special consideration on compassionate grounds such as children placed in foster homes in the division by Child and Family Services will be reported to the Superintendent.
