ADMINISTERING MEDICINES TO STUDENTS

(Prescription Medication and / or Over-the-Counter)

The policy of the St. James-Assiniboia School Division is that medication prescribed to students should be dispensed outside of school hours under the supervision of the parents/guardians. Whenever possible, it is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to make arrangements with the physician to eliminate the need for school personnel to administer medications to students during the school day.

The St. James-Assiniboia School Division, however, does acknowledge that there may be circumstances when students may require medication during the school day as prescribed by a practicing physician The administration of medication in a school setting must be a necessary administration for the health of the child.

The Division will agree to administer medication to students, in collaboration with parents, based on Regulation JLCD-R.
