

ADULT CROSSING GUARDS

1. Appointment of adult crossing guards shall be made by the City of Winnipeg and/or the School Division.
2. The positions will be classified as casual help, to work each day that schools are open.
3. Adult crossing guards shall be selected, trained and supervised by the City of Winnipeg and/or the School Division in consultation with the Police Department representatives.
4. The hours of work shall conform to the established patterns of adult crossing guards within the City.
5. Crossing guards shall be dressed and equipped in a manner which makes them clearly identifiable to vehicular traffic and which is acceptable to any Provincial or Municipal regulations.
6. Requests from the public for adult crossing guards shall be directed to the administration for study.
7. Decisions regarding the establishment of any adult crossing guard position shall take into consideration the following criteria:
 - a) the crossing point leads to an early years school
 - b) the crossing involved is an arterial street
 - c) the numbers of school children crossing
 - d) there are high approach speeds in the area
 - e) heavy vehicular volume during normal crossing times for students
 - f) relevant collision statistics
 - g) presence of traffic control devices
 - h) right turning traffic volumes conflicting with school children crossing
 - i) the intersection is complicated (i.e. number of traffic lanes, existence of center boulevards, railway crossings, geographic factors)
 - j) there are heavier vehicular turning movements
8. Before the appointment of an adult crossing guard is made, a relevant engineering study may be requested.
