REPORT ON EDUCATION

Golden Gate Middle School - Vertical Non-Permanent Surfaces in Math (Building Thinking Classrooms)

Presented By: T. Scott, Dempster, Classroom Teacher and Students

Mr. Dempster and three students provided a presentation on the benefits of vertical non-permanent surfaces and the effect on student learning. The classroom is set up without any desks or chairs, has white boards on all of the walls and students are placed in random groupings to work through a variety of math problems. Research has shown that problem solving is two minutes quicker using this method rather than standard desks and that random groupings encourages a safe environment and encourages all students to work together. By using vertical non-permanent surfaces it makes students learning and thinking visible to their peers and the teacher. It has been noted that student engagement in math has increased as seen through time on task in the classroom.
