DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Approval of Agenda

The Agenda was adopted as circulated.

2. Salary Settlements/CPI

The Board advised the MLAs that COLA language was introduced to teacher settlements as a result of an arbitration that occurred at Pembina Trails School Division. As CPI rates increase, it creates budgetary pressure.

The MLAs responded that they were not aware of how the Government might address School Division budget pressures.

3. 2022/2023 Funding

Administration provided information on how inflation is impacting the non-salary portion of the budget. Many expenses are seeing increases in the double digits.

If Provincial funding does not keep pace with inflation, the School Division will not be able to maintain its current level of service.

The MLAs offered to follow up with government on this matter.

4. COVID Impacts 21-22 Budget 22-23 Budget

Administration advised that the Safe Schools funding has assisted the School Division in addressing COVID-19 needs. However, the School Division did have to mark surplus dollars to assist in additional expenses related to the pandemic as well.

5. Ventilation in SJASD Schools

Administration advised that the Maintenance Department has assessed all ventilation units in school buildings and they are compliant with the ASHRAE standards that the Province has provided.

6. Better Education Starts Today – SJASD Input

The MLAs asked if the Government had sought input from the School Division on the Better Education Starts Today Strategy.

The Board responded that input was not requested from the SJASD Board of Trustees.

7. Community Concerns

The MLAs brought forward a few matters from the community for discussion.
