Sandy Lethbridge was first elected to the St. James-Assiniboia School Board in October 2010, representing the Kirkfield-St. Charles Ward (now West Ward).

She has served on numerous Standing and Ad Hoc committees, most recently as Chair of the former Personnel Committee (2014-22), Chair of the Human Resources/Governance Committee (2022-23), and representative of the Board on the Mental Health Promotion Committee (2022-23). She has also been a member of the former Education and Marketing committees, the St. James Scholarship Foundation, Divisional Early Childhood Education, and Board/Student Council Liaison.
