Principal's Report - Ryan Miller

- Thanks for classroom funding
 - \$150 for each classroom teacher
 - \$100 to each specialist teacher (Phys. Ed. and Music)
- mailbox is pretty full at the school

- Remote learning update
 - 54 students have opted for remote learning
 - Division is supporting 3 methods of remote learning
 - 1. Medically Advised remote learning
 - 2. Code Orange opt in
 - 3. Temporary January opt in
 - if families have opted in for Medical or Code Orange opt in, families are expected to continue to learn from home until code orange is lifted
 - temporary opt in ends on 2020-01-15
 - ~14 students to return on 2020-01-17
 - Remote learning has allowed distance in classrooms
 - accommodation to return to class before code orange is lifted is considered on a case- bycase basis
 - there is currently no plan for extension
- Student enrichment
 - snow hills have been a fun addition to the playground
 - ski grooming will take place in a week or two
 - Bouldering wall in the gym person has been hired to make colored courses
 - kindness week Jan 25-29
 - decisions being made as to what we are doing
 - flashlights received as a give away for kindness week
- ongoing safety protocols are being maintained
 - students are complying with mask wearing
- Kindergarten registration
 - usually in January
 - videos will be provided to parents
 - forms will be available online
 - details to be determined ASAP
