# **Quick Facts**

- → Students will remain with their cohort for much of the day.
- Recess and lunch will be staggered, and students will play in designated areas on the playground with their classroom Cohort.
- → Physical distancing within the cohort is required to the greatest extent possible.
- ★ Students within a cohort will have seats arranged 1 metre apart.
- ◆ Students from 3/4 -3, 4-1, 4/5-25 and 5-26 are required to wear a mask.
- + If cohorts are together in a larger space, **4 metres of distance** will be maintained between each cohort.
- + Classroom learning and Phys. Ed. will be outdoors as much as possible.

#### **Cohort Entrances:**

- ★ Cohort #1: South East Playground Doors
- **← Cohort #2:** North East Playground Doors
- ★ Cohort #3: Daycare Doors on Bruce
- **♦ Cohort** #4: Front Doors on Thompson
- ★ Student drop-off between 8:50 and 9:00.
- Students are encouraged to walk or ride their bikes to school and walk directly to their Cohort Zone.
- Adult supervisors will be at each entrance and on the playground to help direct students to their Cohort Zone.
- Parents are asked to allow children to walk directly to their Cohort zone and leave the area immediately to avoid congestion on the playground.
- Students are expected to follow their classroom teacher's lead and keep 1 metre apart as they enter the doors and walk to their classroom.
- If you arrive late, please call the school and bring your child through main entrance.
- Upon entry to the school, students will hand sanitize.

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# **School Day**

- ★ To start, teachers will focus on practicing routines, building community, and connecting with students.
- → Mental Health and Well Being will be a priority and Project 11 Curriculum will be used support students' return to in-class learning.
- → Literacy and Numeracy, in French and English will be our focus for student learning.
- ★ Students will remain in their classrooms and specialist teachers such as Music, Library, Reading Recovery, Numeracy Recovery, Guidance and Resource will support students in their classrooms.

## Screening

- Screen for symptoms every morning.
  If your child has COVID-19 or flu
  related symptoms, keep them at home.
- If symptoms develop while at school,
  the student will be isolated or kept 2
  metres in distance away from others.
- The student will be provided with a medical facemask.
- → Parents/caregivers will be contacted immediately to pick up their child.
- Please make sure your contact information is up to date with the office.

# **School Supplies**

- There will be no shared supplies. Students will have individual supplies and are not permitted to share material with others.
- Students are to bring the following on the first day:
  - → A lunch
  - → A water bottle
  - **→** Indoor shoes
  - Clothing to support time outdoors
- + Ensure all student belongings are labelled.
