- Discuss and share criteria, reflect on written works to obtain or provide feedback

## NUMERACY: PROBLEM SOLVING

Students will improve their willingness to engage and ability to persevere solving authentic math problems. Students will develop their ability to effectively communicate their understanding /thinking/reasoning.

- Understand the common problem-solving assessment criteria
- Use a variety of strategies, models and materials to make sense of the mathematics in a task.
- Explain their ideas and reasoning in small groups and with the class; listen and evaluate the reasoning of others.
- Persevere through tasks; recognize that struggle is part of the problem solving process.
- Effectively represent and communicate problem solving processes, strategies and solutions
