Numeracy:

Students in Grade 2 and Grade 3 will demonstrate improvements in their conceptual understanding of basic facts, their flexibility in making computations, and their automaticity when recalling facts. This will allow them to focus on more complex problem-solving rather than basic calculations.

ELA:

Students in Grade 4 and Grade 5 will demonstrate improvements in generating ideas and effectively communicating their ideas in writing.

Specifically:

Grade 4: Expanding on the three supporting ideas; intro and closing sentences, transitions, and focus on voice.

Grade 5: Deepening the understanding of voice, fluency, and exploring writing across the genres. Focus on form, audience, and purpose.
