



Crestview School Kindergarten Information Evening 2026

The Crestview School Kindergarten Registration Information Evening for parents and caregivers with children that will be entering Kindergarten in September 2026 will take place on February 3rd at 7:00 p.m. at Crestview School.

Parents and caregivers with children born in 2021 are encouraged to attend this session to learn what to expect in the fall as children reach this important milestone. At the information evening, parents will be provided with registration forms and instructions. Registration forms can also be accessed online at the Crestview School Website.

No registration is required to attend this information evening.

Kindergarten at Crestview are full days.

How to Register for Kindergarten at Crestview School

Registration for Kindergarten (and Early Years students new to Crestview will take place on February 6, 2026. Please take the following steps to register:

1. Confirm that you are in the Crestview School catchment area. This can be done via School Locator on the SJASD Divisional Website.
2. Attend the Crestview School Kindergarten Registration Information Evening. Student Registration Forms and specific instructions for registration will be provided at the information session. If you are unable to attend the evening, visit the Crestview School Website to download a Registration Form and obtain registration instructions.
3. Complete the Student Registration Form. If you have accessed the registration form online (PDF), please ensure you download it before you fill it out, or the form will not save your work.
4. Deliver the completed registration form to the school office. Registration forms will be accepted at the school office beginning February 6, 2026.

To finalize your child's registration please bring the following documentation with you:

- A Birth Certificate for your child.
- Two Proofs of Residency (such as a Manitoba Health Card, valid Manitoba Driver's License, Lease Agreement, House Title, or other official document indicating address of residence).
- If your child was not born in Canada, citizenship papers or one of the following documents: Permanent Resident Card, Record of Landing, Valid Work Permit/Visa, or Valid Study Permit.

Literacy Links 2026

Literacy Links is a FREE summer literacy program in the St. James-Assiniboia School Division that supports parents in understanding how to develop a positive literacy and numeracy environment in the home setting. Children will be engaged in a wide variety of play-based and enriching learning experiences during the Literacy Links sessions.

A literacy facilitator will demonstrate and provide hands-on activities which support early literacy and numeracy development, build fine motor skills, and create a strong connection between home and school.

Children will receive a series of six virtual sessions using Microsoft Teams with their Literacy Links Facilitator. A home package of play-based materials will be dropped off for children to engage with on the other side of the screen. Feedback from parents has been extremely positive:
