We have many special activities planned to celebrate our love of reading here at Crestview.

<u>Feb. 6th</u> - We will kick off **I Love to Read** month with an **assembly** to highlight some of the upcoming activities for the month. Mr. Bell will read a book to the whole school.

Feb. 9th- Wear a t-shirt with words. Students are encouraged to wear clothing with words.

<u>Feb.10th / Feb.17th / Feb.24th</u>-Flashlight Fridays. Students can bring a flashlight to school so they can read with the lights out in their classrooms.

Feb. 14th- Wear pink and red for Valentine's Day. Students will be reading stories about Valentine's Day at school.

<u>Feb. 16th- Reading is a bright idea.</u> Students can wear sunglasses, a hat and bring a beach towel to read books on.

Feb.23rd- Pajama Day and Cuddle up & Read night. Students can wear pajamas to school all day and then come back to school in the evening with their families for Cuddle Up & Read 6:00-7:00 in the gym (milk and cookies, bookmarks and a book draw)

Spotted Reading- Students who are "spotted reading" might find their picture on our bulletin board. New readers will be featured each week.

<u>Lunch Reading Club-</u> We will be offering a Reading Club for <u>grade 1</u> students. The club will meet Wednesdays at lunch from 12:20-12:50 in the library beginning on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>February 8th</u>. There will be a draw for books each week.

<u>Guess the Reader</u> – A bulletin board will be created featuring pictures of staff members reading their favorite children's books. Only a small portion of the staff member will be revealed behind their favorite book and students will try to guess who is hiding behind the books.

Reading Checklist- A Reading Checkilist will be sent home on Monday, February 6th. All cards returned on or before <u>Friday</u>, <u>February 24th</u> will be entered in a draw. You do not need to complete all activities, just do as many as you want to.

<u>Story Snippets</u> – Students will have the opportunity to hear part of a book and guess the story of the day in order to enter their name in the prize draw.

Jar of Words- Students will try to guess how many words (message hearts) are in a jar.

Bookmark Exchange- Students will create bookmarks and exchange with another class (reading buddies) or keep their own bookmark if they choose.

<u>Story Quilt</u> – Students will be creating a classroom story quilt by drawing pictures of their favorite books on square pieces that will be assembled together to make the quilt.
