## **Entry/Dismissal**

#### Your specific entrance/exit:

- + Entrance Door: South West Door to the school off back playground. (See map attached)
- ✤ The school day begins at 8:55 am.
- The school day ends at 3:43 pm
- On the first day, if you are unsure where to go, entrances will be marked. Please ask a staff member for assistance locating your door.
- Students are expected to keep 2 metres apart as they enter the doors and walk to their classroom.

- + If you arrive late, please enter through the main entrance by buzzing the office.
- Please refer to the map previously sent for drop off and pick up zones.
- Upon arrival at the school, students line up and will be met by their teachers entry to the school.
- + Hand sanitation will occur at each entrance.

## **Quick Facts**

- You will remain with your cohort for much of the day. Outside time and lunch will be staggered. Grade Level Wings have been established.
- Physical distancing within the cohort is required to the greatest extent possible. Students within a cohort will have desks arranged 1 metre apart.
- If cohorts are together in a larger space, 4 metres of distance will be maintained between each cohort.
- + Phys. Ed. Will be outdoors as much as possible
- Band/Choir/PA will be on pause for the month of September and possibly longer.
- Students will be eating in their classrooms. Microwaves will NOT be available. Lunch Program forms need to be returned. Students can go out for lunch, however they cannot return until the lunch break is over. Lunch hour Cohort 3 11:45 -12:10 and Cohort 4 12:15-12:40.

## School Day

- Start times and dismissal times have been staggered.
- Regular curriculum will be followed in all subject areas.
- PA will focus on Project 11(Mental Health)
- Students will remain in their classrooms and teachers will move to the students.

#### Screening

- Screen for symptoms every morning. If your child has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, keep them at home.
- If symptoms develop while at school, the student will be isolated or kept 2 metres in distance away from others. A space will be designated in the school.
- The student will be provided with a medical facemask.
- Parents/caregivers will be contacted immediately to pick up their child.
- Please make sure your contact information is up to date with the office.

#### Masks

- + Masks are required at school.
- You will be provided with 2 reusable masks, to be picked up before school begins
- Masks must be on before entering school
- If you're unable to pick up your mask prior to the first day, masks will be available at your designated entrance.

## **School Supplies**

- There will be no lockers for the month of September and maybe longer.
- + Students will have to carry their supplies in their backpack.
- Students are to bring the following on the first day:
  - A binder with paper and dividers
  - A pencil case with writing materials
  - + A lunch
  - + a water bottle
  - clothing to support time outdoors
