In preparation for the registration process for grade 9, Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate has arranged three opportunities to support the registration and course selection process.

Learning Expo – January 21, 2026 - 1:00 – 5:00pm

All Golden Gate Middle School Grade 8 students are invited to attend a **Learning Expo** at Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate where Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate students will showcase learning in curricular and co-curricular programs that are offered at their school.

This event will allow grade 8 students the opportunity to experience learning, first-hand, before making the transition high school.

We will make the arrangements to schedule a time for your child's class to attend with their teacher in the afternoon. Students will either walk or bus (depending on the weather) over to the high school with their teachers for this event at their scheduled time.

Course & Program Information Session for Gr 8 Students – February 6, 2026

Administrators from Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate will visit Golden Gate Middle School on this day to share specific course and program information for grade 9 and beyond. Students will be given a draft copy of the course selection sheet during this session so they can mark courses of interest and note any information shared to take home for further discussion with their caregiver, before the official registration form is sent home on February 6th.

Caregiver & Student Registration Evening –February 10, 2026 - 6pm

On this evening, grade 8 students from Golden Gate Middle School who currently reside in the school division are invited to attend an information session at Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate. This is an opportunity to learn more about what should be considered before selecting courses and submitting the completed registration forms. There will be a formal presentation where administration will share key considerations and program information. Following the presentation, teachers will be available in their classroom spaces to answer any questions parents/caregivers and students may have, and school administrators and Student Services staff will be available to help with registration form completion where needed.
