Back to School

The 2019-2020 school year will start on Tuesday, September 3rd with a division wide inservice, so there will be no school. Once again, Heritage School will continue with the Opening Day Interviews for September 4th and 5th for Grades K-5. These two days will NOT be regular school days, **but students and their parents** <u>are expected to attend</u> and are recorded present on the school attendance form. The objective is to provide the opportunity for the student and parent to meet the new year's teacher in a relaxed, informal setting. We are aiming for 100% attendance. <u>The first day of classes will be</u> **Friday, September 6th.**

Homeroom teachers will be located in their homerooms. Following that visit, parents and students are invited to meet the specialist teachers – Phys. Ed., Music, French, Resource, and Guidance in their rooms.

School hours will be varied to try to accommodate working parents.

September 5 th	10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Parents are responsible for the cost of providing supplies for their children. We request that each Kindergarten student bring <u>\$45.00</u> to cover the cost of school supplies (i.e. pencils, crayons, glue, notebooks, duo-tangs, special crafts, classroom projects, etc.) Purchasing supplies in bulk provides uniformity of supplies for all children while utilizing the most cost efficient means. <u>PLEASE BRING</u> **YOUR PAYMENT TO THE INTERVIEW.**

If paying by cheque, please make it payable to <u>Heritage School</u>. If you are unable to pay this cost at one time, please complete a payment schedule with your child's teacher at the interview and leave it with the teacher. <u>All payments are to be completed by mid November</u>.

Each student will also need to bring a pair of running shoes (for indoor use) and a back pack. Running shoes should <u>not</u> be the skateboard type as they need to be tied tightly for running and games in the gym. Please ensure that your child's name is on these items.

<u>Remember</u> to drop in during the outlined times at your convenience. You do not need to call the school to arrange an appointment. **<u>Regular classes will begin on September 6th, 2019.</u>**
