If your child attends daycare, they will be dismissed to daycare. If something changes and your child will not be attending daycare, please let your classroom teacher and daycare know. Otherwise students are dismissed at the hardtop.

Parking Lot

Our parking lot is a very busy place as parking is shared by school staff and daycare staff. We thank everyone who follows our signage for speed and no parking zones as it really does keep things safe. While we know it is convenient to park in the no parking zones, this creates issues when emergency vehicles need access to the school, and they do come to the school more than you would think. Please take a few extra moments to park in the 15 minute drop off zone or visitor spots, especially if you are dropping off for daycare. If you are dropping off in the morning, please drop off and quickly exit so that a spot is free for the next family.

Entry and Exit

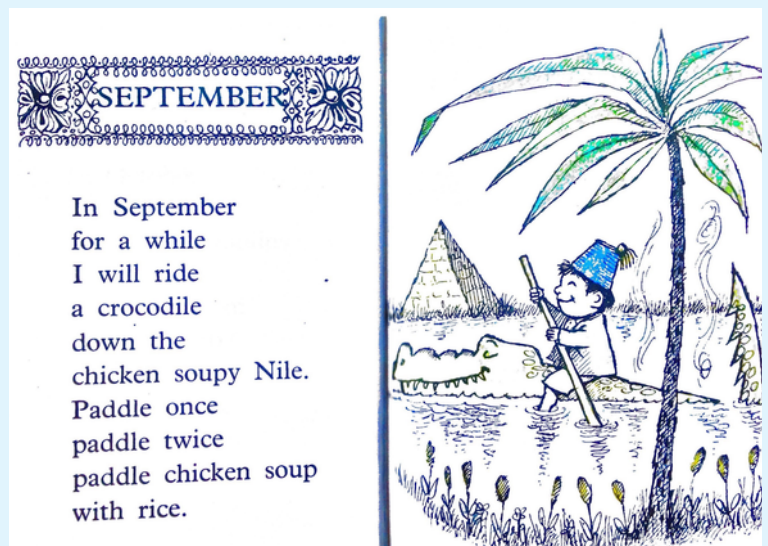
Students enter the building at the beginning of the day from the hardtop at the back of the school. This is also where students are dismissed. Should your child be coming late, they would need to enter via our main entry. Our main accessible entry is on the southwest side of the school. Once you enter you will see another locked door in the vestibule. Press the bell image on the keypad and the office staff will open the door. We share this entry way with the Heritage Park Childcare Program. If you need access to the Childcare Program, you would press 5 or 9. Our main priority is for the safety of all students, staff and guests. We ask that when you come into the building, you proceed directly to the office where we can then assist you.

Communication

We are always here to hear your suggestions, questions and concerns. If you do have a concern, please make contact with your classroom teacher first as they are the ones who usually have the most information. Our teachers will be using the SeeSaw platform as a way to communicate with you. As soon as it is up and running, we will send you the information for you to access your classroom account.

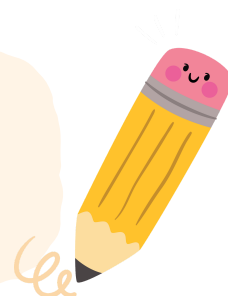

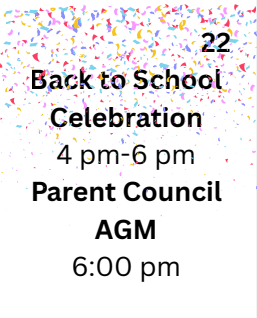
