LAST YEAR'S AREAS OF FOCUS

What did the evidence of student learning tell us?

Jameswood Alternative School staff focused on supporting students to develop a personal vision for success through building knowledge, skills and goal setting strategies for academic revision and improvement. Jameswood Alternative School staff designed and implemented significant programming intended to assist students with developing healthy pro-social behaviours through improved coping and self-regulatory strategies and opportunities to practice these skills. Developing a personal vision for success in the 2024-2025 school year, Jameswood students benefited from strategies to increase engagement in learning as part of a multi-year goal. At regularly scheduled PLC Meetings, teachers reviewed observational data and shared specific strategies that were effective for individual students so they could be implemented across curricular areas.

What are the anticipated next steps?

In 2025-26, teachers will assess and develop appropriate, individualized intervention with students, to engage students in reflection about their own learning needs. Teachers will use these reflections as part of their assessment plan. Teachers will use this information to guide instruction that is responsive to student needs while continuing with our focus on developing healthy pro-social behaviours through improved coping and self-regulatory strategies. The option also exists for interested senior years' students to participate in either Environmental Math 15F or Family Studies 15F alongside, for a full credit total.



To improve students' independence by improving their interpersonal communication skills; we will be focusing on:

- 1. Communication
- 2. Reasoning
- 3. Persistence
- 4. Resilience

We are continuing our focus into the 2025-2026 school year by engaging families more intentionally (teacher/student 1:1 conferencing).

The staff at JAS also plan to engage a variety of guest speakers who can share their experiences related to our identified areas of focus; we hope this will help inspire our learners.

The staff at JAS also plan to engage a greater number of families and caregivers in the programming that impacts the success of their student. At JAS, reconciliation is a lived commitment.
