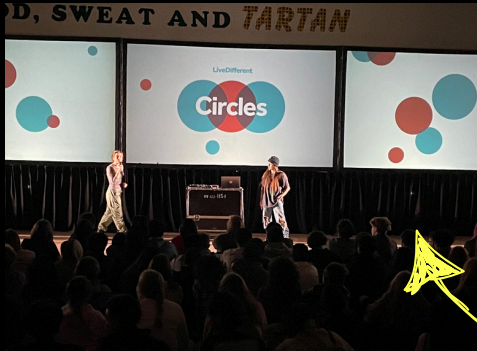

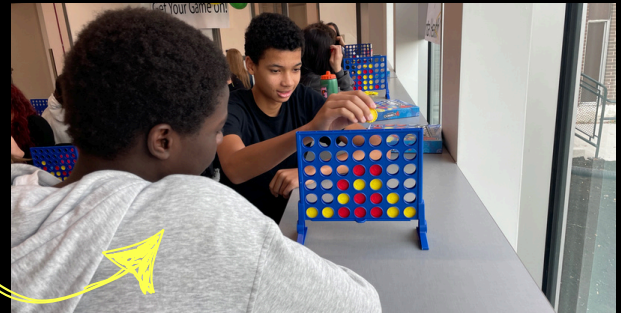


Our first whole-school presentation by Live Different was an interactive event where focussing on values-centered approaches and choices. Great messages shared with all!
