 - Math 20S Essential or Math 20SPA (Intro to Applied/Pre-Calc)
 - Geography 20F
 - Science 20F
 - Phys Ed 20F
- **Compulsory courses for Grade 11**
 - English 30C
 - Math 30S Essential, Math 30S Applied or Math 30S Pre-Calculus
 - History 30F
 - Phys Ed 30F
- **Compulsory courses for Grade 12**
 - English 40S
 - Math 40S Essential, Math 40S Applied or Math 40S Pre-Calculus
 - Phys Ed 40F
