All awards are subject to change based on external funding. This list is intended to be used as a guide for students and is not comprehensive.

To be eligible for awards, all students must have completed 40 Community Involvement Hours as per SJASD policy.

The John Atamanchuk Memorial Award - \$100.00

This award is presented to an exceptional student who is actively involved in school activities and displays a positive attitude.

Deer Lodge Centre Scholarship - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$100.00

This scholarship is presented to a student entering health care studies with the highest average of possible candidates.

The Jim & Lillian Huggard Memorial Award - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$500.00

This award is presented to a student who is actively involved in community events or school activities over a number of years.

Student Council Recognition Award - \$150.00

These awards recognize the work of the student council executive.

John Taylor Social Justice through Philanthropy Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a graduating student who understands and values human rights by recognizing the dignity of every human being and has modeled the principles of social justice

John Taylor Drama Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a student who has demonstrated potential as an actor/actress and who has participated in theatre plays/improv.

John Taylor Dance Award - \$150.00

This award is presented for dance excellence and outstanding leadership in dance performance.

John Taylor Athletic Award - \$100.00

This award is presented for highest commitment to the athletic program at John Taylor.

John Taylor Visual Art Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a student who displays excellence in the Visual Arts program.

John Taylor Choral Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a student who displays excellence in the Choral program.

John Taylor Band Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a student who displays excellence in the Band program.

John Taylor Musical Award - \$150.00

This award is presented to a graduate(s) for four consecutive years of contribution to the spring musical and for outstanding citizenship.

ANAF – Unit 283 Pipes and Drums - \$150.00

The recipient of this award has a passion for music and is pursuing a post-secondary education in music

Royal Canadian Legion Scholarship - St. James Scholarship Foundation –\$350.00

This scholarship is presented to a student with strong leadership, good citizenship and academic standing, and participation in interscholastic or performing arts.

The John Taylor Music Parents’ Association Instrumental Music Award – \$150.00

This scholarship is presented to the student displaying musical excellence and outstanding citizenship in the band program.

John Taylor Music Parents’ Association Jazz Award - \$150.00

This award is presented for outstanding citizenship and musical excellence in jazz.

John Taylor Music Parents’ Association Choral Award - \$150.00

This scholarship is presented to a student displaying dedication, participation, and citizenship in choral music.

Penny Mead Memorial Scholarship - \$100.00

The recipient of this scholarship intends to continue their education in music at the post-secondary level.

Lifetouch Leadership Award - \$250.00

This award is presented to a student active on the Grad committee, is advancing to post-secondary education, and who has displayed outstanding leadership in school activities.

Lifetouch Scholarship - \$200.00

This scholarship is presented to a student who has been active in school organization and plans to go on to further educational studies.

This scholarship is presented to a graduating student who has been active in school and community activities and will be continuing with further educational studies.

Gordon Chipman Memorial Scholarship (Optimist) - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$250.00

This scholarship is presented to the school valedictorian.

John Taylor Staff Award - \$100.00

This award is presented to the graduate(s) who has displayed school spirit and assistance to both staff and students.

St. James Art Club Award - \$50

This award is presented to an outstanding graduating art student in the Grade 12 art program.

St. James Optimist Scholarship - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$250.00

This scholarship is presented for excellent academic achievement and participation in extra- curricular activities.

St. James Masonic Lodge Awards - \$200.00

These awards are presented to a Special Education who has shown marked improvement in their program.

Student Services Special Achievement Award - \$100.00

This award is presented for excellence in Work Experience.

Charlotte Lee Memorial Award – St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$200.00

The recipient of this award displays positive attributes at Work Experience.

Moe Kowalson Award - \$500.00

This award is presented to a graduating student who displays excellent citizenship, with exemplary volunteer hours within the school and community, and is a good role model.

St. James-Assiniboia School Division Volunteer Award - \$100.00

This award is presented to students for contributions to volunteer service and activities.

Jostens Advanced Placement Ring Award – Class Ring

This award is presented to the six students with the highest average on their three best AP course scores.

Perfect Attendance Award - \$100

This award is presented to students who have perfect attendance.

Friesens Photography Award - \$200

This award is presented to a student in recognition of excellence in photography.

Madison Claven-Enns Memorial Award - \$100

This award recognizes a student who demonstrates the ability to face challenges and successfully graduate from high school.

Darcee Gosselin Memorial Award - \$200

This award recognizes outstanding volunteer efforts in extra-curricular activities at John Taylor Collegiate.

Momentum Subway Fundraising Award - \$250

This award recognizes the significant efforts of John Taylor students who raise funds to support programming.

Zeid Family Food Fare Award - \$500

This award is presented to a student who demonstrates good citizenship and is pursuing post-secondary education.

John Taylor Collegiate Piper Hockey Leadership Award - \$1000

This scholarship is presented to a multi-year player with good character, exceptional work ethic, and a who is a positive role model.

Westview Dance Scholarship \$200

This award is presented to a student who has demonstrated excellence in the area of dance performing arts.

Doug Eyolfson Youth Action Award - \$250

This award is presented to a graduating student who has voluntarily taken action to make a positive difference at school and/or in the Charleswood – St. James – Assiniboia – Headingley constituency.

Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship - \$1000

This scholarship is presented to a graduating student who has an active mind and lifestyle and demonstrates leadership qualities.

Cambrian Credit Union Learning for Life Award - \$1000

This award is presented to a graduating student who displays leadership skills, participates in school and community activities, and plans to pursue post-secondary education.

Emergent Biosolutions Scholarship - \$400

This award recognizes a student who achieves high standing in the sciences and is pursuing a post-secondary education in Life Science

Academic Achievement Awards

St. James-Assiniboia School Division Cash Awards – Advanced Placement -\$500.00

This award is presented to students who have completed minimum of 2 Advanced Placement courses and will be calculated based on the following academic criteria:

- 1 English credit: EN42, EN40SC or EN40SL (highest percentage)
- 1 Math credit: MA42, MA40SP or MA40SA (highest percentage)
- Next 3 highest 42S or 40S level courses
 - These courses may only include with a maximum of two courses from any department.

St. James-Assiniboia School Division Cash Awards – Academic -\$500.00

This award is presented to students with the highest academic average in regular Grade 12 courses and will be calculated based on the following academic criteria:

- 1 English credit: EN42, EN40SC or EN40SL (highest percentage)
- 1 Math credit: MA42, MA40SP or MA40SA (highest percentage)
- Next 3 highest 42S or 40S level courses
 - These courses may only include with a maximum of two courses from any department.

University of Manitoba Chown Centennial Scholarship - \$1000.00

This scholarship is presented to a graduate who is entering the University of Manitoba in the fall of their graduating year and is based on the highest average of **all** Grade 11 and 12 courses.

St. James-Assiniboia School Division Award of Excellence Runner-Up - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$500.00

This award is presented to the graduate with the second highest academic standing based on the following criteria:

- 1 English credit: EN42or EN40SC or EN40SL or EN40ST (highest percentage – must be the course for which the provincial exam was written)
- 1 Math credit: MA42 or MA40SP or MA40SA (highest percentage)
- and any four Grade 12 Level S courses with a maximum of two courses from any department.

St. James-Assiniboia School Division Award of Excellence - St. James Scholarship Foundation - \$1000.00

This award is presented to the graduate with the highest academic standing based on the following criteria:

- 1 English credit: EN42or EN40SC or EN40SL or EN40ST (highest percentage – must be the course for which the provincial exam was written)
- 1 Math credit: MA42 or MA40SP or MA40SA (highest percentage)
- and any four Grade 12 Level S courses with a maximum of two courses from any department.

Governor General's Award - Medal

This award is presented to the student with highest academic average of **all** Grade 11 and 12 courses.

The following awards require specific applications to be submitted and the recipients are selected by the benefactors, not the John Taylor Collegiate Awards Committee. Application forms available from our guidance department.

John Taylor Alumni Scholarship – Pay It Forward Award - \$1000.00

The recipient of this scholarship has a minimum 75% average, displayed service through involvement in school and community activities and will be entering post-secondary education immediately upon graduation. The recipient will also be eligible to continue this scholarship for Year 2 and 3 of post-secondary studies.

John Taylor Collegiate Alumni Scholarship – 50th Reunion Award - \$1500.00

The recipient of this scholarship has a minimum 75% average and is involved in school activities at a high level. This student must be involved in community service activities or volunteering in the community. This student must be attending university immediately upon completion of high school.

Merit Contractors Association of Manitoba Scholarship - \$500

This scholarship is offered to a qualified Manitoba High School Student who is enrolled in a degree or diploma program in the study of the construction trade or a construction related occupation or profession at University or College (Proof of enrollment is required). Preference will be given to a student who is a member of or has a parent who is a member of the Merit Contractors Association of Manitoba and who displays promise in the field of chosen career.

University of Winnipeg Entrance Scholarship

This scholarship is presented to students who have high academic standing in their top five Grade 12 courses of which two must be Mathematics and English.
