#### **Definitions:**

**Scholarships** - are given to students who show academic achievement, volunteerism and community leadership

**Awards** - are given to students based on academic achievement, leadership (and/or) financial need

**Bursaries** - are given to students who show financial need – *requires a financial aid application to be filled out prior to receiving money*
