Dear Grade 7 Band Students & Parents,

October 4, 2019

The St. James-Assiniboia School Division Grade 7 Band Trip to Camp Arnes **October 17-18, 2019** is less than two weeks away! There are about 200 students from all six middle schools in our division preparing for our inaugural division-wide Grade 7 Band Camp. This letter will provide information including details, medical information requirements, expectations, itinerary, etc. Parents, please go over this information with your child to make sure he/she knows what is going on and to help make this a positive experience for everyone.

Informational Meeting

All parents are invited to our Camp Arnes Informational Meeting Wednesday, October 9th at 6:30 p.m. in the theatre at Hedges Middle School (369 Fairlane). This presentation will be about 30 minutes long and will expand upon the information provided in this letter, give you the opportunity to meet the parent chaperones and teacher supervisors involved, and allow questions relevant to the trip.

Medication

School **URIS** files will be taken on this field trip. If there are updates necessary, please contact the school. If your child requires staff to administer medications while at the camp or if your child will be self-administering prescribed or over the counter medication, it is absolutely necessary for you to fill out the attached forms and return them to your child's Band Director prior to the parent meeting October 9, 2019. No medications can be administered to students without these forms being filled in.

Guidelines for Students

In order to help make this a positive experience for everyone, we all need to be aware of some guidelines to help make things run smoothly.

- 1> Please respect other people, property, and yourself at all times.
- 2> Please listen to and follow instructions when asked.
- 3> Please be on time for all rehearsals and activities.
- 4> Please respect the "lights out" time each night. For safety reasons it is extremely important students stay in their assigned rooms each night. In the event of an emergency, we need to know where everyone is.
- 5> This is a school activity which means student behavior must be appropriate to the school setting. (If you can't do it at school, you can't do it at camp.)

<u>Please note</u>: Refusal to follow the above guidelines or other inappropriate behavior may result in one or more of the following consequences for a student:

- -Suspension from any remaining trip activities.
- -Parents being contacted.
- -Students being picked up early or sent home at the expense of the family of the student.

What to bring?

Students will need to bring the following items to camp with them.

- ✓ Instrument and pencils (don't bring your music you will get new music at the camp).
- ✓ Extra reeds, valve oil, slide cream, cork grease, etc.
- ✓ Watch, reading material, cards, snacks (peanut and nut-free) for the bus and free time at camp.
- ✓ A variety of warm clothes including a jacket. Students should be prepared for cooler, wet weather. Please be sure that student clothing complies with school dress codes. Bring a swimsuit for the pool.
- ✓ 2 pairs of shoes (1 pair should be comfortable walking shoes for recreation times).
- ✓ Sleeping bag, pillow and a bed sheet.
- ✓ Towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush, comb, and other personal toiletry items.
- ✓ Water bottle, hat, suntan/block lotion, mosquito repellant.
- ✓ Please eat your breakfast prior to departure on October 17th.

Students are responsible for their own instrument and personal items. Please make sure these items are labeled with the student's <u>name and school</u>.

Bus Pick-up and Drop-off

There will be four Beaver Bus lines buses used to transport students and parent to and from camp. In order to minimize complications, there will be four pick-up locations October 17th at 7:40 a.m.: Golden Gate, Hedges, Lincoln and Ness schools. Students from George Waters will catch the bus at Golden Gate (330 Bruce Avenue) and students from Bruce will catch the bus at Hedges (369 Fairlane Avenue. When we return to Winnipeg on October 18th, buses with more than one school on them will drop off at Hedges and Golden Gate at 4:30 p.m. and then continue on to Bruce and George Waters and arrive there at 4:50 p.m. Parents, please be certain to make arrangements for your children to be picked up as soon as they arrive at their school.

Itinerary

Students will be split up into three Bands: Beethoven, Mozart and Tchaikovsky. They will rotate through full rehearsal, sectional rehearsal and recreation to ensure there is a good balance of learning and recreation while at camp. Students will also be placed in dorms and will be supervised by Band directors, parent chaperones at all times to ensure the safety of all participants. Thank you to all of our parent
