Outdoor Classroom: The drawings are now at $90 \%$ complete. We will get detailed drawings sent to us. What is the timeline for tender? Contractors get three weeks to submit bids and then Little Bluestem will coordinate with the division. We are awaiting some final replies on grant applications. Little Bluestem would help us with selecting a contractor that balances cost and service. We will be in contact when funds are secured.

## Grant Updates:

Tree Canada Grant did not come through. We are hopeful for the provincial grants and some of the smaller opportunities.

## Simply K Fundraising Setup:

All is now setup, and we are waiting to be linked to our PAC bank account. We will look to have all donations, fundraisers, and more run through this site. We will be sure to publicize and communicate out successes and needs for the community and plan for overage for annual maintenance, signage, and increased costs. We will aim at $\$ 150,000$

## Treasurer's Report:

Chequing account: Payments and deposits were discussed. Current amount $=\$ 12,433.57$
Savings account: Minimal action as this is only used for the toonie draw account. $=3804.71$
Pizza raised $=\$ 367.31$

## Fundraising:

Pizza Day's will be revised to include all students each week.
$\$ 1300$ was raised for the Mom's Pantry Orders. We will commit to doing this again in the near future. $\$ 600$ was raised through Purdy's orders and will be delivered to the school for distribution. A cash prize was decided upon and we will do this all online through Simply K. \$1000, $\$ 500$, and $5 \times \$ 100$ prizes with some student Polo Park gift certificate prizes. ## 3. Recent School Events, Clubs and Supports of/for Learning:

## - Academics:

- Report Cards for term 2 are almost completed. Parent conferences to follow on April 13 ${ }^{\text {th }}$.
- All ELA teachers met across two mornings to mark on-demand writing samples for consistency and to identify targeted needs as we move into the final term.


## - Arts:

- Concert and Rock band rehearsals continue. Our Rockband will be performing at the School of Rock in the spring and our concert band will be in transition based on Mr. Kehler's leave.
- Our Lincoln Dance Team will be entering the Canadian National Dance Championships (CNDC)
- Arts Education program is under review based on student feedback and staffing needs.


## - Athletics:

- Both basketball teams are playing in the finals on Tuesday evening after a season full of growth and commitment by both players and coaches. Student and family spectators have been a welcome addition to the season.
- Badminton, spring ultimate, and flag rugby will be starting soon after spring break.


## - School Wide Initiatives and Upcoming Events:

- Spring Spirit Week occurred at the end of the month highlighted by costumes and events throughout the week.
- On February $23^{\text {rd }}$ we had a virtual MADD presentation for our grade 8 students.
- On February $23^{\text {rd }}$ we had a Pink Shirt Day with presentations from the WPS for all grade 6 and 7 students.
- On March 3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$, GetReal Virtual Presentation occurred for all students on the topic of Black History month and diversity.
- We hosted a community vaccination clinic on March $16^{\text {th }}$ with over 30 participants in attendance.
- Our next Celebration of Success will occur in April due to our extended basketball season. The plan is to have this event occur on Wednesday, April $13^{\text {th }}$.
- Virtual parent conferences will occur on the evening of April $13^{\text {th }}$. Those unable to get an appointment will be offered times on the morning of April $22^{\text {nd }}$.

- Wood railing guards at west door to be replaced over spring break.
- We're waiting for the painters to begin!

- Staggered exits, Grade 6 cohorts and spacing requirements are no longer in place.
