As an inclusive and culturally responsive school, we are welcoming all students to learn about First Nation, Métis, and Inuit traditions.

Smudging is an Indigenous tradition that involves the burning of traditional medicines. Smudging allows people to become mindful and centered, better able to hear, see, think, speak, and act in a good way. Participation is always voluntary. It is done in a designated area on school grounds and is approved by the Division's Workplace Health and Safety Officer to ensure that there is proper ventilation. ## Information about Big Sand Club Volleyball:

- Club Season is just around the corner. Big Sand will be running 3 club teams this year. 2 at the 14U level and 1 at the 15U level.
- 14U Athletes (born in September 2011 or later.) 13U athletes are welcome to try out.
- 15U Athletes (born in September 2010 or later)
- Tryout information can be found on the Big Sand Website:
- Team will be picked following tryouts (12 per team)
- Season runs from January until mid-May
- Club Volleyball is all Tournament based (no league play at all)
- All Tournaments usually occur on weekends (Friday- Saturday) (Saturday-Sunday)
