This year, our Lincoln Terry Fox Run will happen on Wednesday, September 24th at 2:40pm. On that day, students will take part in walk/run through the back field of the school. Students will also have a special virtual presentation from a Terry Fox ambassador on September 11th to kick off our Terry Fox fundraising.

Students will have the opportunity to discuss the heroic efforts of Terry in the days leading up to the event and are encouraged to raise much needed funds in support of cancer research.
