At-Home Remote Learning Continues:

As announced Thursday by the Government of Manitoba, due to high COVID numbers and an encumbered healthcare system, at-home learning will **continue for the week of May 31-June 4th, 2021** with all current arrangements and schedules in place. We anticipate direction from the Manitoba Government to return to in-class learning on June 7th, 2021. Your child's schedules and weekly assignment information can all be found on Microsoft Teams.

*Attendance does count. If you know your child will be unable to attend online, please use the school messenger app to excuse them from their classes for illness, appointment or otherwise. Attendance will be consolidated at the end of each day and parents will receive notification of an absence on the following morning by a school staff member.

What: A 5km fun run held in our community (a 2.5km loop will also be an option)

When: Monday, May 31st, 2021 and the entire week following (deadline to submit times is June 6th).

Why: To build a strong community relationship between our five schools, be active and have fun!

Runners have the option of completing either a 2.5km or a 5km loop. The start and finish line are both located at École Robert Browning in the northeast school yard.
