GENERAL ART

This one-semester, one credit course is open to all levels of skill and abilities. Projects are both 2and 3-dimensional with Fridays being open-studio for independent work. Projects will involve research, sketching, experimentation and art making. There is no student fee for this course and students are required to have a 9x12 sketchbook.

ADVANCED ART

This year-long, two credit course is designed for students who are highly skilled in art making. Advanced students are chosen to stay in the program if they display the skill level, maturity and commitment to the program. Projects involve research, sketching, experimentation and art making. Advanced students pay a \$60.00 per year student fee and receive their own art kit and classroom supplies. They are required to have a 9x12 sketchbook.
