- 1. Called to order- 6:02, moved Marian, seconded, Diane.
- 2. Past minutes- Brea motioned to accept the minutes, Marian seconds, all in favour, motion passed.
- 3. Pizza Day- Dominoes now has communication that we prefer they be early rather than late, cheese pizza first if order is split. Plate, napkin supply replenishment not needed at this time. Brea is using an online scheduling program moving forward to manage volunteers and Ms.Nuytten will be included (in office) to assist with additional volunteers if needed.

- Request for 1000.00 for the grade 8 International Music Camp program to hire clinicians, etc. Camp takes place at the end of May. Marian motions to accept, Brea seconds, all in favour, motion passed. Marian prepared the cheque to issue ASAP.
- Lincoln registration happening now, please spread the word in the community. Out of catchment and division will wait for letters of acceptance.
- Grade 8 band went to optimist festival this week, were adjudicated well. Mr.Kehler will be playing in the WSO Star Wars vs Star Trek, playing trombone.
- Universal washroom is finished, up and running. Students were given information; there has been only positive feedback so far.
- The school board has put a soft cap in place for High School registration. This will mostly
 affect those wanting to attend Sturgeon Heights, but will be observed for all registrations.
 All grade nine students will be required to register at their catchment school, and will be
 allowed to apply out of catchment for grade 10+. An appeal process is in place to handle
 extenuating circumstances, including siblings already attending, etc. Grade 8 students and
 parents have been notified.
- 6. Staff appreciation- March 6, 13, and 20. Brea has made posters for each grade to encourage participation. Info will go into Friday news. There will not be themes this year.
- Student Council- Student council attended last meeting to speak about the logo. See information from January minutes. Their questionnaire results were approved.
