1. Laurie motioned to approve minutes from Nov 23, 2022. Joanna 2nd. MOTION PASSED.

2. Reports

2.1 Chairperson's Report

Seat raffle raised \$640 for gift baskets (\$440 cash, \$200 gift cards).

Silent auction/gift basket tickets were sold for \$5 each or 3 for \$10. \$1030 raised.

Year's fundraising total (since Sept 2022) \$2155.50.

TruEarth fundraiser will continue until June 2nd. 20% of purchases goes to Linwood. The website manager, Share-a-sale, will mail a cheque when minimum \$50 is raised. Share-a-sale website shows funds in USD. Fundraising page shows all \$ in CAD.

Daycare construction next door is underway during off-hours. Library use is not impeded.

3. Outstanding Business

3.1 Linwood Pantry

5 families consistently need support, with others asking for help occasionally.

Linwood Pantry would help feed families as a whole, including food for the weekend. Right now, snacks are provided at school, but we hope to increase access to protein (eggs, nut or seed butter, canned fish, etc).

No fridge available at school now; Principal Nuytten will apply for grant from the Winnipeg Foundation or other community grant for funds to purchase one.

3.2 Pizza day end of February

Pizza Hotline: \$10+tax/pizza, charge \$2/slice. 10 pieces/pizza, probably 20 pizzas. Cheese, pepperoni & Hawaiian. Google form survey -favourite pizza & likelihood of participation. May trade tickets for pizza after payment, or just pay & choose.

Option for subsequent pizza days: Pizza, drink & applesauce.

3.3 Spring Fundraiser

Council agreed to forgo a Spring fundraiser, due to fundraising overload. Classes continue to collect donations for various causes & celebrations, and we may ask for contributions to Linwood Pantry.

Each class will choose a basket theme for auction.

4. New business

- 4.1 Deer Lodge social March 11th to fundraise for after school programming & equipment. Looking for high school volunteers. Regine will check if Linwood is officially allowed to publicize the event. It will directly benefit many Linwood families.
- 4.2 I Love to Read month is in March, before Spring break. Ms. Aremu requested a \$50 increase to the celebration budget. Laurie motioned to approve \$150 extra for I Love to Read month, with receipts from Mrs. Jones; 2nd by Sandra. **MOTION PASSED**.

Total I Love to Read budget: \$350. No receipts required for first \$200.
