COUNCIL BUSINESS – Parents asked questions about half-day Kindergarten and thought full-day Kindergarten important after the lack of connection and opportunities for students during Covid. The principal mentioned that Kindergarten and school staffing depends on whole school student numbers. There were also questions around staffing levels for guidance and resource and what kinds of supports are most important for students. The principal said that information collected at the school demonstrates that a specific focus on responding to Indigenous students' needs will be important to ensure they thrive. There was discussion about how Indigenous students could be best supported (school-based and division supports) and input from the community was offered and invited. Members also discussed fundraising ideas for the school that they could support with their time and talents, and then ended the meeting with the thought to connect and plan the first meeting.
