- + First day of School: September 8th, 2020 (8:55-3:40)
- Based on Manitoba Public Health Guidelines, masks are mandatory for gr. 4/5 students in schools.
- Please share up to date information for multiple emergency contacts for your child with the office.

Entry/Dismissal

Your specific entrance/exit:

- + Arrive between 8:45 & 8:55.
- + Line up beside the play structure with lines out into the field (do not use the field/structure)
- Gr. 4/5 South Door to the school. (See pic attached)
- + The school day begins at 8:55am.
- The school day ends at 3:40pm
- On the first day, if you are unsure where to go, please ask a staff member for assistance.
- Students are expected to meet their teacher & to keep 2 metres apart as they line up & enter the doors to walk to their classroom.
- If you arrive late, please wear a mask, enter through the main entrance with your child & come straight to the office.
- The staff parking lot is not for student drop-off or pickup.
- Students will sanitize their hands as they enter the school.

Quick Facts

- + Students will remain with your cohort for much of the day. Outside recess time and lunch will be staggered.
- Physical distancing within the cohort is required to the greatest extent possible. Students within a cohort will have desks arranged 1 metre apart and will have personal sets of supplies to use during the day.
- If classroom cohorts are together in a larger space, 4 metres of distance will be maintained between the class cohorts (e.g., recess)
- + Phys. Ed. will be outdoors as much as possible
- Music will be on pause for the month of September and possibly longer. Instead there will be a greater focus for students on mental health awareness
- Gr. 4/5 students can stay for lunch or go home depending on parents' schedules, but once they are signed out for lunch, they should not return until the end of their lunch. (12:20-1:15 PM)

School Day

- The beginning of the year will run on an alternative model
- Core curriculum and required courses will be the focus for the return to in-class learning.
- Students will remain in their class & teachers will move between classes if necessary (e.g., Phys. Ed.)
- Frequently touched surfaces sanitized multiple times/day.

School Supplies

- Students will not use cubbies or cloakrooms for the month of September & maybe longer.
- + Students leave supplies in their desk or backpack.
- + Students will have individual sets of supplies. & resources.
- Students should bring the following on the first day:
 - + Lunch (if they are staying)
 - + Hat/sunscreen
 - + a full water bottle
 - clothing to support time outdoors

Masks

- Masks are required at school & on the bus for grade 4 & 5 students.
- Students will be provided with 2 reusable masks that can be picked up before school begins
- Masks must be on before entering school.
- + Please contact the school to pick up your child's mask.

Screening

- Screen for symptoms every morning using the MB Public Health Screening Tool. If your child has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, keep them at home.
- Students with symptoms will be isolated/supervised in a designated spot, provided a medical facemask.
- Parents/caregivers will be contacted immediately to pick up their child.
- Manitoba Public Health will contact affected families with instructions if there was exposure to a positive case.
