Laurie moved to fund Gr 5 grad up to \$500. Joanna 2<sup>nd</sup>. MOTION PASSED.

Laurie motioned to approve \$200 for I love to read week in March, with potential of more funding with receipts. Sandra 2<sup>nd</sup>. MOTION PASSED.

Possible activities for I love to read week:

- Book exchange
- Each class wins a book: every day, 2 names will be drawn at announcements, to win a book for their class. 11 books funded by parent council.

- Ask Ace Burpee (radio personality) to read in classes again.
- Have community members (especially authors) read to classes & answer questions.
- In Feb, ask community members and students to write stories with a positive message to share with classes electronically or in print.

Laurie motioned to approve \$1000 for the Teacher Wishlist. Joanna 2<sup>nd</sup>. MOTION PASSED.

- Tanya Jensen requested funds for duck eggs & incubator from Morningsound Farm. Last year's chick hatching was a big success. Morningsound is an animal sanctuary/petting zoo.

Winter concert 50/50 fundraiser is likely. Will vote on it at next meeting. May try a backwards raffle to thank parents: parent council donates a gift basket & all concert attendees may enter the draw.
