### Notice to Parents/Caregivers: Dogs Prohibited on School Division Property

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As a safety precaution for all students and staff, we would like to remind our school communities that dogs are prohibited on all school division properties. This City of Winnipeg By-Law and school division policy is in place to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone on school grounds.

This reminder does not conflict with the allowance of animals in schools and on school grounds, provided they receive prior approval through the school principal or Superintendent/CEO. Approved animals may be beneficial for the following purposes:

- Supporting curriculum and educational practices
- · Enriching the learning experience of students
- As a service or non-service animal

The prohibition of dogs on school division property is strictly for the safety of students and staff. While we understand that pets are an important part of many families, the presence of dogs on school grounds can pose risks, including potential injuries and fear responses.

We appreciate your cooperation in adhering to this policy. By doing so, you help us maintain a safe and secure environment for all members of our school community.
