Student Appointments

When a child has an appointment etc. and will be picked up outside of regular school dismissal times, ***parents are required to sign out their child(ren) from the school office.*** To maximize learning time and minimize disruption to classroom instruction, students will be called to the office upon arrival of a caregiver.

End of Day Dismissal

A reminder to all parents/guardians of children who to take the bus to contact the office directly if there is a change to transportation plans. It is expected that bus students will take the bus if there is no parent contact advising of a different arrangement.

The end of the day is a very busy time in the hallways of Phoenix School. Students are moving in many directions for our bus lines and exit doors. Congestion in the hallways needs to be minimized to ensure that all students are dismissed safely by Phoenix staff.

In this light, Phoenix families who are picking up their children are asked to continue the practice of waiting for their child(ren) at a planned “meeting spot” outside at the end of the day.
