Modular Classrooms Update

Thank you to the Province of Manitoba and SJASD for securing three new learning spaces to address programming space at Phoenix School.

The building structures were delivered during the last part of summer break. Ongoing construction has continued from the start of September to establish power, technology, and accessibility requirements for the spaces.

As the spaces are being constructed, student play areas have been shifted to the North areas of the Phoenix playground and the construction space has been isolated with safety fencing.

Please continue to watch for additional Information regarding project status and construction timelines that will be shared as it is received and decisions are made.

Electrical work continues to progress on our modular classrooms. This work will continue over the next few days. Most recent construction timelines indicate that final completion of the modular classrooms is scheduled for January/2024.

After careful consideration of programming needs for Phoenix students and staff, please note the following learning space updates:

- The music program has been temporarily relocated to the library. The music program is scheduled to return to the music room in January.
- In January, the library is scheduled to relocate to one of the completed modular classrooms, creating additional programming space in the school.
