On Wednesday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, we will be holding our annual Project Fair. Students may enter one of 4 types of projects:

- Experimental Science Project (An investigation, which uses the scientific method, to test a specific question)
- Study Science Project (Research-based report on a topic)
- Innovation/Design Project (The student builds or designs a prototype or model for a given purpose)
- A Heritage Project (A research-based project with a Canadian or local theme)

All students are encouraged to participate, however, it is not mandatory. Classroom teachers will discuss the Project Fair with their students to provide them with details about the Fair. It is then up to students to decide which type of project they'd like to work on. Students are responsible for ensuring their projects are completed on time and according to the guidelines set.

Once your child has decided on a type of project, he/she can return the bottom portion of this letter to their homeroom teacher. Further information, including project guidelines, a schedule of events, and judging criteria will then be available for viewing on our Phoenix School website.
