- 6. Winter Concert:
 - a. Primary (Kindergarten, Room 9, 4 and 8 + Gr 3 in room 3 = 103 students) will be in the afternoon at 1:00 p.m. The doors open at 12:40.
 - i. **The hall sits 240 people and there are 103 children**. Each student will get 2 tickets with 34 tickets remaining. In the past we have always been able to accommodate all requests for extra tickets. In addition, the parent community is very good about returning any unwanted tickets.
 - b. Intermediate (Rooms 3, 15, 16 + Gr. 4 Room 3 = 57 students). Performance is at 6:30 with the doors open at 6:00 p.m.
 - i. The hall sits 240 people and there are 57 students. Each student will get 4 tickets with 12 tickets remaining. In the past we have always been able to accommodate all requests for extra tickets. In addition, the parent community is very good about returning any unwanted tickets.
- 7. A sub-committee needs to be established to begin planning for the outdoor classroom. We are entitled to apply for a grant to a maximum of \$5,000.00 from the school division. We need to have a plan in place and money already raised so that the construction will not take too long after the money is awarded to the school from the school division.
