-Arrival Time: 2:00pm - Parents and students can choose to come beforehand, however the Student Choir Prep Space will not be available until this time.

-Sansome Performance Time: 2:25 - 2:45pm

-Parking: Parking will not be available onsite at the Legislature, parking will be available at the Canada Life parking lot, or surrounding street parking.

-Drop Off: Parents and kids are asked to enter the building via the West side basement entry (beside Osborne St), accessible via a ramp. Parents of choir students will be allowed to drive onto the Legislature grounds to drop off their kids/other adults but will need to park at the Canada Life parking lot. Upon entry volunteers will assist in directing students to the Student Choir Prep Space.

-Release Form: The event is being live streamed on YouTube, as a result the Legislative Building requires parents to complete the attached release form. 

Just a reminder that student drop offs and pick ups are not permitted on the west side of the building due to safety concerns. All students can be dropped off in the east side parking. Please note the west side parking lot will be inaccessible to vehicles other than for staff parking during drop offs (8:45 a.m -9:15a.m.) and pick ups (3:40 p.m- 4:05 p.m.).
